WHICH COURSES SHOULD YOU TAKE?

All Farrell Area School District requirements such as PSSA exams and senior projects shall be completed prior to graduation.

Therefore, careful thought and consideration should be given to the selection of challenging and rewarding courses for your high school years.

Decisions about course selections are important due to their long-range effects on your future life. Decisions reached by you and your parents at the end of the course selection process will be considered a firm commitment with FASD.

Many factors that contribute to success in high school, colleges, business schools, vocational/technical schools, and potential employers will give the greatest weight to your high school course selections and the grades you receive.

The seven periods in the Farrell Area School day allow 35 periods per week to schedule classes. A complete schedule should include courses that meet graduation requirements and/or electives that reflect your interests, personal strengths, and career objectives.
