125. ADULT EDUCATION

1. Purpose
SC 502,
1901

The objectives of the adult education program shall be to provide adults and out-of-school youth an opportunity for continuing education to develop intellectual, vocational and creative skills.

The program shall strive to help adults increase their capacities, their satisfaction in life, and their sense of responsibility toward membership in an ever-expanding community. The program also shall endeavor to satisfy adult desires for training for new jobs; upgrading in their present occupations; preparing to meet problems of the home, family, and community more adequately and effectively.

2. Authority
SC 1904

The Board shall establish the enrollment fee and class size for students attending classes in the adult education program.

The Board may charge an additional fee for classes where expendable materials are used by the students in order to make the class work effective.

3. Delegation of Responsibility

The administration is charged with the responsibility to develop and implement specific objectives designed to provide appropriate adult educational opportunities for the citizens of of the community.

Fees necessary to implement these programs for adults and out-of-school youth shall be set by the administration prior to the development of each year's annual budget.

It shall be the responsibility of the administration to evaluate continually the program offerings, staff, materials, equipment, supplies, facilities and fee schedules to ensure their compatibility with the needs of the adult community and the means of the school system.
