127. EVALUATION OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

1. Purpose

The Board directs the staff to present evidence of achievement or lack of achievement of pupils in light of the schools' goals. It is clear that factual evidence of the productivity of the schools is the Board's best device for evaluating the educational system, for guiding improvement efforts, and for fostering approval of schools.

2. Delegation of Responsibility

Title 22
Sec. 5.203

The Board directs the Superintendent to develop and implement a systematic short-range and long-range plan for the continuing qualitative assessment of the progress of the educational program toward the goals established by the Board. To this end, the Superintendent shall recommend such tests and methods as may be indicated by generally accepted professional practice and best professional judgment.

Pol. 112

The administration will establish and maintain a standardized basic testing program which can be used, communicated and interpreted by the staff for all residents.

The district testing program shall include those standardized tests required by State law, and all such testing shall be conducted by the guidance staff.

3. Authority

The Board reserves the right to review any test and to approve those which serve a legitimate purpose without infringing upon the personal rights of the students or their parents.

Parents may obtain an explanation of the results of their child's test from qualified school personnel.
