217. GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Purpose

SC 1613

It shall be the policy of the Board to acknowledge each student's successful completion of the instructional program appropriate to the student's interests and needs by the award of a diploma at fitting graduation ceremonies.

2. Authority

SC 1611

The Board shall award a regular high school diploma to every student enrolled in this district who meets the requirements of graduation established by this Board.

The Board requires that each candidate for graduation shall have earned twenty-one (21) credits.

The Board shall identify the planned courses for which credit toward graduation shall be awarded. These written plans shall be on file in the district and shall be made available upon request for review by the designated representatives of the Department of Education.

3. Guidelines

The requirement for graduation shall be the completion of work and studies representing the instructional program assigned to grades nine through twelve.

The fourth year of high school shall not be required if the student has been accepted by an accredited institution of higher learning.

Pol. 233
