Dear Parent or Guardian,

The Farrell Area High School will once again be administering the Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSA) from <u>April 9<sup>th</sup> through April27<sup>th</sup></u>. The English/Language Arts and Math tests will be given during the week of April 9<sup>th</sup> and April 16<sup>th</sup> to all 7<sup>th</sup> and 8th graders. The Science test will be given during the week of April 23<sup>rd</sup> to all 8<sup>th</sup> graders. We will be on an adjusted schedule on April 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, and 24<sup>th</sup>. The schedules are enclosed.

A student's score will fall into one of the following categories – *Advanced, Proficient, Basic, or Below Basic.* It is our sincerest wish for all of our students to do their very best and achieve *Proficient or Advanced* status. Accomplishing this will take a concerted effort not only of the school, but also of each household. Please assist us in our efforts by impressing upon your child the need to *do their very best, leave nothing blank, to get plenty of sleep and to be on time* for school each day.

As always, please refrain from signing your child out during school hours. We ask that you schedule all appointments for *after* school hours. In addition, there is a strict *No Cell Phone Policy* during testing to maintain optimum security. If a student is caught with a cell phone, it will be taken from them and you will be required to retrieve it at the end of the school day. If a student is caught breeching security (i.e. use of a cell phone, cheating on the test) a possible expulsion could occur. We especially need your compliance in this matter during the PSSA testing to us help maintain the optimum testing environment.
